



WorleyParsons profit, but not for long

Engineering work has stopped for WorleyParsons as the firm's profit is set to fall for the second year in a row, according to a report from the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX).

The firm's profit for the year ended 30 June 2009 was \$10.1 million, up from \$4.1 million in the previous year. Revenue for the year ended 30 June 2009 was \$1.1 billion, up 11.1 per cent.

Revenue for the year ended 30 June 2008 was \$997.4 million.

Chief executive John O'Neil said the firm's profit was a good performance for the firm, given the economic conditions.

WorleyParsons is expected to report a profit of \$10.1 million in the year ended 30 June 2010, with revenue of \$1.1 billion.

WorleyParsons is a global engineering and construction firm, with operations in 15 countries, up from 12 in the previous year.

"We are very encouraged by the results of our operations," said O'Neil.
